Living the Great Commission

The call, "Therefore Go...", is a call to action! The words represent the mobilization of a person or a group of people to leave the place currently occupied in order to influence someone or something in another area. The church is called to "therefore go" yet the phrase is not exclusive to the work of the Gospel. It seems there are organizations, other than the church, that heed this command more frequently, and if the church is completely honest...more faithfully. However, there is no organization that has a more important message, nor plays a more significant role in the spiritual/eternal lives of people than the church!

As a member of the Millville Fire Company I volunteer alongside men and women who are in tune with the sentiments of this statement. The call to "therefore go" is evident every time the "tones drop" for Company 230, or for that matter any volunteer fire company. It can be in the middle of a family dinner, a family Christmas party, birthday party, sporting event, or even a church service. The call to "therefore go" can happen in the middle of the night, the early morning hours, or anytime in between. The call to "therefore go" can happen during a significant snow storm, a heat wave, or any other weather event.



When the pagers are tripped or an alert is received on a cell phone volunteer fire department personnel will drop whatever they are doing, if possible, and go to serve those who are in crisis at that present moment. A house fire, forest fire, car accident, illness, assistance to another fire company, ambulance call, rescue operation, traffic control, etc...When there is a need for someone to be rescued from a car accident the company is alerted, "Rescue 230 you are due at the scene of a car accident with entrapment!" These instructions provide enough information for responding personnel to mentally prepare for what they will be attending to when arriving on scene. The training we received allows for a mental process to begin, What tools may be needed? What hazards may be present? What other resources may be needed? What situations might we face

when we arrive? Will other personnel be need? No matter the situation there are dedicated volunteers who are willing to respond and provide aid to people who are in life threatening conditions, experiencing traumatic situations, or confronting the loss of personal property!

As a member of the UMC I serve with other men and women in an organization called to heed the command, "Therefore Go"! The call is not passive in any way, shape, or form. The call to go is active, exciting, and humbling when we are devoting ourselves to the work of God's Kingdom. In 2018 I would like to encourage the church to fully embrace this idea, as well as to call each one of us to actively serve Jesus Christ by reorganizing our priorities to incorporate the idea "Therefore Go"!

The image on this page shares the theme for 2018 (you will see these around the church mid January). "Therefore Go" and this command positions us to bring the life changing message of John 3:16 ("For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.") to the world in which we live. We are called to rescue the world by introducing them to the Savior! Jesus sounds the alarm in sharing John 4:35 when He says, "... I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest." Jesus alerts us to the needed rescue operation. It is a rescue operation intended to introduce spiritually dying people to Jesus so that He might transform their lives and provide them with eternal life!

Rescue 316 is the call to "therefore go" and take the message of Jesus Christ to the world we live in day after day. Implementing this may require some training so that we have the skills needed to effectively introduce others to Jesus. We may need to assess whether we have the proper tools on board to help others grow in their relationship with Jesus. It may mean looking at the resources we provide to help people learn about sin, Jesus, salvation and Christian living. We may need to look closely at our present ministries and determine if we are meeting the needs of our community. We may need to learn how to interpret the command "therefore go" so we effectively build God's Kingdom here on earth.

Whatever the case may be we should all be prayerfully seeking God's guidance for our individual lives as well as for the entire church. Are you willing to respond to the call to "Therefore go" at any moment? Are you willing to rearrange plans in order to be used by God? Are you willing to schedule time for this rescue operation to the world around us? Think about the words of Jesus in the Great Commission, "18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20.

May God bless us all in the New Year and may we be compelled to respond to His calling upon us as we live the gospel message for all to experience!








We are continuing the "Superbook" series as our DVD lessons. These wonderfully done animated movies are a must for every child and even adults to watch!
